
#### APRIL BUILDER OF THE MONTH THEME: "I CAN USE KIND AND COURTEOUS WORDS"

# SAT TESTING TO BEGIN MONDAY, MAY 2<sup>ND</sup> – 6<sup>TH</sup>

We will be starting our SAT testing the week of May 2<sup>nd</sup>. We will also have additional kindergarten testing that will last until the end of May.

For the SAT, snacks will be provided periodically throughout testing. If your student has food allergies, please provide the school with personal snacks. We know our students are super smart and we want to do whatever we can on our end to help them be successful. These are just a few ideas that our families can implement at home during the month of April and May:

- 1. Early to bed
- 2. Well-balanced meals, healthy snacks
- 3. Continue to read with student every night
- 4. Be encouraging, excited and positive about tests
- 5. Be aware of television, computer and electronic usage time.
- 6. Discuss with your student and help them understand the reason and importance of testing
