The annual Fall Festival will be held next Friday, September 16 in the Draper 2 gym and on the soccer field between the Draper 2 and Draper 3 campuses (11938 S Lone Peak Pkwy) from 5pm to 8pm. This is an all-Draper campus event (ELC, D1, D2, D3).

Wristbands for students can be purchased in advance for \$7 or at the door for \$9. The wristband gets your student an all-access pass to slides, bounce houses, obstacle courses, mechanical bull, laser tag arena, wacky trikes race course, Hungry Hippo Challenge, Eliminator (think "Wipe Out"), photo booth, and carnival games. You can also purchase a family pass for \$30 for all of the students in your immediate family. Other activities include face painting, henna art, and a dunk tank. Clubs and organizations will be selling pizza, popcorn, bake sale items, soda, cotton candy, and snow cones. These other activities and items for sale are not included with a wristband purchase.

We are also selling meal tickets for \$5. Get your choice of a hamburger, cheeseburger, or hot dog with chips and a bottle of water for just \$5.
